Administrator

Purpose of processing personal data

Personal data will be processed for the purpose of correspondence with natural persons in matters related to the economic activity of the administrator, including the identification of the person contacting the administrator, consideration of the matter reported via the contact form and for marketing purposes.

Legal basis for the processing of personal data

The legal basis for the processing of personal data is Art. 6 sec. 1 lit. f GDPR (Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46 / EC (general regulation on data protection), i.e. the legitimate interest of the administrator consisting in correspondence with natural persons in matters related to the economic activity of the administrator.

The period of personal data processing

Personal data will be processed until the purpose for which they were collected, resulting from the subject of correspondence, ceases to exist. In addition, data may be stored for the period specified in applicable law, as well as for the period of determining, investigating or defending against claims.

The rights of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data

You have the right to:

- access to your personal data and obtain a copy thereof,
- supplement or correct personal data,

- deletion of personal data,
- requests to limit the processing of personal data,
- object to the processing of personal data.

The right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority against unlawful processing of personal data

You also have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory body dealing with the protection of personal data. In Poland, this authority is the President of the Personal Data Protection Office, ul. Stawki 2, 00 - 193 Warsaw.

To what entities will personal data be transferred?

Personal data provided in the contact form may be made available to entities supporting the administrator in its activities, including entities providing hosting services.

Voluntary provision of personal data

Providing personal data is voluntary, it is not a statutory or contractual requirement. However, failure to provide the information indicated in the contact form will make it impossible to answer the question or consider the matter presented via the contact form.

Automated decision making

Your personal data will not be used for profiling or making any decisions about you automatically.
